Print Media Accreditation – Application Guidelines

Thank you for your interest in applying for accreditation for Blenheim Palace International Horse Trials (BPIHT). The guidelines outlined below are intended to assist with your application.

- Priority will be given to fully completed applications – application does not guarantee accreditation.
- Failure to complete all sections of the application may result in a delay and your application being declined.
- All applications must be received by Monday 16th August 2021. Applications received after this date will be declined.
- All applications must be made through the official application service available via www.bpiht.co.uk Applications received in any other format will be declined.
- Applications from Freelances will only be considered if supported by a separate letter from the Commissioning Editor of the publication you will be representing at BPIHT on company letterhead along with copy of your work/images previously used in print. Any Freelance applicants who fail to provide this information will be declined. Students will not be accredited.
- You will be informed by email as to whether your application has been successful or not.
- Car Parking is available
- After BPIHT it would be helpful if you could provide copy of your coverage to aid with any future applications you may make.
- It is a condition when issuing accreditation that it must be clearly displayed at all times at BPIHT and is not transferable. Any persons found to be disobeying this rule will have their accreditation removed and will not be permitted to re-apply for a period of five years.
- Any member of the media attempting to gain access to the prohibited areas which their accreditation does not allow will have their accreditation withdrawn.
- All accredited media at BPIHT are requested to comply with the Guidelines and any instructions given to them on the day from BPIHT Officials and security staff. Failure to do so will result in the removal of all privileges.
- The Media Centre will be open from 9:00am until 7:00pm from Wednesday 15th September – Sunday 19th September.
